

Ryegrass Staggers. Will It Affect You?

The Facts¹:

- Outbreaks of Ryegrass Staggers occur annually in Southern Victoria and Tasmania.
- Serious outbreaks occurred in 1981, 1986, 1993, 2002 and 2005
- In 2002, an estimated 100,000 sheep and 500 cattle died in Victoria as a result of Ryegrass Staggers.
- High risk seasons are likely where lush spring growth under warm, wet conditions is followed by hot, dry summer.
- Toxins concentrate in the seedhead and crown of the grass.
- Danger Months – December through to May.

The condition commonly known as “Ryegrass Staggers”, or more accurately as Perennial Ryegrass Toxicosis (PRGT), can be a serious and widespread problem in livestock grazing perennial ryegrass dominant pastures during summer and autumn months. It affects sheep, cattle, horses and alpacas. The most commonly recognised sign of PRGT is ‘staggering’, which may occur within a few days of exposure to infected pastures, hay or silage.

Less obvious signs may include ill-thrift, especially in young stock, heat stress, scouring and dags, reduced fertility and lowered milk production. Deaths also occur from mishaps due to lack of coordination, such as drowning in creeks and dams.

Perennial Ryegrass Toxicosis (PRGT) is caused by two toxins, Ergovaline and Lolitrem B. These toxins are produced by an endophyte fungus that lives in the plant. The fungus is not harmful to the grass, and in fact benefits the plant by enhancing seedling vigor, tillering, seed production and resistance to drought and insect pests. However, the toxins produced by the fungus can cause considerable problems in the livestock grazing infected pastures. Toxin production is usually highest when the rye grass goes to head and during new season growth following summer rains. The toxins are concentrated in the seedhead, stem and crown of the plant, but at lower levels in the leaf.
